Beginning Spanish Conversation with Señora Shores

This class introduces students to Spanish language and Latin American culture with fun and memorable activities. Students will engage in art, movement, songs and cultural activities to develop basic Spanish vocabulary and an understanding of cultural norms. Classroom learning activities will include listening and pronunciation of basic concepts of self, numbers, colors, families, home and nature. Research has shown that students need a minimum of 5 hours per week to develop a second (or third) language. We will engage in active classroom learning two hours per week and students will bring home a variety of engaging activities to target vocabulary in home practice. Home activities are important to reinforce language acquisition and students' long term retention.
